Climate ethics (CE) has become an emerging field in applied ethics. CE is not just a sub-discipline of environmental ethics but has its own moral and ethical profile. Meanwhile, CE is not just about mitigation and future generations but has enlarged onto adaptation, climate engineering, allocating burdens, and distributive justice.

The article "Domains of Climate Ethics" (Baatz & Ott, 2012) summarizes recent developments in CE and proposes a coherent set of yardsticks for orientation within the different topics of CE.
